#### Will my time be paid for?

Many roles are funded, especially for donor-backed projects. Others will be pro-bono because the budgets are unavailable. You'll always be told upfront.

#### What's the expected notice period?

Deployment windows vary. Some are weeks in advance, others 48 hours where urgent response is needed. You'll only be asked when it fits your stated availability.

#### Can I decline a role?

Yes! There is no obligation. You control your involvement.

#### Can I refer someone else?

Absolutely. We welcome referrals of trusted, experienced professionals.
